

## **Common Mistakes When Monitoring Vital Signs:**

Allowing the horse to sniff your hand to measure respiration rate. Not regularly practicing on your horse to know what is normal. Double-counting heartbeats (lub-dub=one beat).

Not leaving the thermometer in long enough (false low-temperature reading). Taking vital signs on a nervous horse (horses' pulse and respiration rates can increase dramatically if they are nervous).
